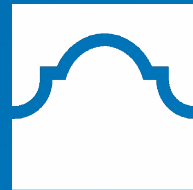

Mixing Up Question Types

- Adding subjective questions that require a deeper understanding can also curb cheating. Below are a few examples of methods that can aid in that :
 - Compare and contrast
 - Relating a concept from class to the student's own life
 - Pose a problem and instruct students to provide and defend recommended solutions
- Create questions that help safeguard against cheating
