Canvas Assignment Tool

The Canvas Assignment Tool allows you to create assessments and assignments that are synched with your Gradebook.

Key features:

- Easily Organize and Grade Online Submissions
- Create Due Dates and Restrictions
- Promote Collaborative Learning with Peer-Review and Group Assignment Options
- Add Rubrics
- Weight Grades





Grading and Weighting Assignments

Canvas Assignments are already synched to your Gradebook, making grading **so** much easier!

- The **Assignments Page** allows you to create Assignment Groups to weight assignments.
- You can create **Rubrics** to ensure consistency in your grading and communicate expectations to students.

- Assign a **value** that matches the assignment's importance
- Provide the time, instructions, and resources necessary for your students to be successful
- Design to prevent plagiarism and, when applicable, use **Turnitin**.
