Setting up the Breakout Room

Meeting Topic: Breakout Room 1 [Assign](#)

Host:

Invitation URL:


Participant ID:

- Move all participants into breakout rooms automatically
- Allow participants to return to the main session at any time
- Breakout rooms close automatically after: 30 minutes
- Notify me when the time is up
- Countdown after closing breakout room
Set countdown timer: 60 seconds

Recreate Options Add a Room Open All Rooms







- **Click on “join” when invited**

- **Click “Leave Breakout Room” when you are ready**






Canvas Assignment Tool

The Canvas Assignment Tool allows you to create assessments and assignments that are synched with your Gradebook.

Key features:

- Easily Organize and Grade Online Submissions
- Create Due Dates and Restrictions
- Promote Collaborative Learning with Peer-Review and Group Assignment Options
- Add Rubrics
- Weight Grades






Grading and Weighting Assignments

Canvas Assignments are already synched to your Gradebook, making grading **so** much easier!


- The **Assignments Page** allows you to create Assignment Groups to weight assignments.
- You can create **Rubrics** to ensure consistency in your grading and communicate expectations to students.
- **SpeedGrader** provides an easy-to-use interface for organizing and grading your student's work.







Selecting Settings

- **Be Intentional** – Select settings that further your instructional goals
- Consider whether this is a **formative** or **summative** assessment
- Decide if this is a **collaborative learning activity** or **individual assignment**
- Assign a **value** that matches the assignment's importance
- Provide the **time**, **instructions**, and **resources** necessary for your students to be successful
- Design to prevent plagiarism and, when applicable, use **Turnitin**.
