




## CENTRAL TEXAS TECHNOLOGY CENTER:




## NORTHEAST LAKEVIEW COLLEGE:

Northeast Lakeview College is one of the five Alamo Colleges. Located in northeast Bexar County, one of the fastest growing areas in the state, it currently serves northeast San Antonio and residents from Comal and Guadalupe Counties, with about 37% of its students coming from these counties outside of Bexar. Northeast Lakeview College offers associate degrees, technical programs, and certificate offerings to prepare students for employment for in demand careers. NLC continues to expand its footprint into the New Braunfels and Seguin communities, partnering with New Braunfels ISD and Comal ISD to offer dual credit programs. Additionally, NLC continues to expand programs and course offerings to include more options in Science and Technology, while continuing to offer traditional courses.






